

PLAYGROUND CORVETTE CLUB MINUTES
4 February 2026

The meeting was called to order by Eddie Carafa at 1900, at Rick's Crab Trap, 178 Eglin Pkwy NE, Fort Walton Beach, FL 32548.

Welcome All! And welcome to our new member, Joe Foy, owns GT Mustangs and a 2025 Red CS and is a supporter of the Cancer Freeze Car Show.

1. Treasurer's Report presented by Peggy.
2. Ambassador Report: (see full report on website/email)
 - a. Eddie spoke about Dave Lithway from Hammock Bay Classic Cars. Eddie is going to invite Dave to attend one of our meetings.
 - b. Our savings balance saw no change through January 2026. However, there are several outstanding checks with Wreaths Across America.
 - c. Fran Hendricks won the Trivia Question prize for the evening.
 - d. Steve Noble shared information concerning the delivery of Corvettes at the Natural Corvette Museum delivery experience. The RAT program includes mini corvettes (you-drive-it) for children; an opportunity to rebuild your engine; family entertainment; treasure hunt; each child receives a \$50 gift certificate; General Motors sends a group to this program.
 - e. He reminded the members about the upcoming MICHELIN BASH NCM to be held April 23-25, 2026
 - f. He also reported on the Points Program. We received 496 points last year. This year we earned 1,108 points worth \$480, exceeding the 200-point-limit. That is excellent for a club our size. Furthermore, it means level 3 for us.
 - g. Steve also related information about a program the NCM hosts for underprivileged children to spend time at NCM, learning about different STEM programs concerning Corvettes' technology, car production, etc. Cost per child to attend is \$500.
