

PLAYGROUND CORVETTE CLUB CORRECTED MINUTES

July 8, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Eddie Carafa, at 7:00 PM, at Pedro's, 315 Mary Esther Blvd., Mary Esther FL.

An additional \$610 was collected from the members during the meeting. Eddie added that the Club donates funds to eight different worthy community organizations yearly.

Eddie emphasized the importance for members to purchase the PCC silicone wristbands at a cost of \$99.99 to help advertise our organization. The bands will be ordered around August this summer or shortly thereafter.
